THE IMPORTANCE OF ENVELOPES

Many parishioners don't seem to understand the importance of using parish envelopes when donating to the Church. Yet this is the best way to demonstrate that you are a practicing Catholic who attends Mass regularly. Why is that important? If you are asked to be a godparent, the Church where the baptism occurs often asks for a letter from the Church where you are registered saying that you are a faithfully practicing Catholic. Letters like that are sometimes required for school scholarships, tuition supplements, weddings, even burials. If you simply put cash in the basket during Mass, it's difficult for the Church office to verify that you were here week after week. Using envelopes allows us to see that you're here regularly when we're asked to verify that fact. It also allows us to give you a tax record of your donations upon your request. No matter how much you choose to donate, please use envelopes. Call the parish office to obtain your box of envelopes.
