**THE IMPORTANCE OF
ENVELOPES**



Many parishioners don't seem to understand the importance of using parish envelopes when donating to the Church. Yet this is the best way to demonstrate that you are a practicing Catholic who attends Mass regularly. Why is that important? If you are asked to be a godparent, the Church where the baptism occurs often asks for a letter from the Church where you are registered saying that you are a faithfully practicing Catholic. Letters like that are sometimes required for school scholarships, tuition supplements, weddings, even burials. If you simply put cash in the basket during Mass, it's difficult for the Church office to verify that you were here week after week. Using envelopes allows us to see that you're here regularly when we're asked to verify that fact. It also allows us to give you a tax record of your donations upon your request. No matter how much you choose to donate, please use envelopes. Call the parish office to obtain your box of envelopes.

CONFIRMATION

In the past at St. Bernard, children were confirmed in the 2nd grade when they received the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. Our Pastor, Fr. Robb prefers to confirm at the older age. If your child is a grade 8 and has not yet been confirmed, please call Margie at 778-4769 or 730-9510 so we can plan a schedule to prepare your child to be confirmed at the Easter Vigil Mass next year.

Are you an adult practicing Catholic who has been baptized but never received the Sacrament of Confirmation? Live your faith to the fullest. Don't keep the Holy Spirit waiting any longer to give you the grace and blessings God as always intended for you. Call Margie so we can plan a schedule to prepare you to be confirmed at the Easter Vigil Mass next year.

FROM THE DIOCESE

Are you currently in a marriage which is not recognized by the Catholic Church? Are you free to marry but thinking of entering marriage with someone who has been previously married and divorced? If so, the staff of the Tribunal for the Diocese of Venice is willing to examine this situation with you so that your standing in the Church can be determined. The Tribunal is the only agency in the diocese with the juridical power to examine and resolve such cases in the external forum.
